WASHED AWAY.....Saturday night's scheduled game between the Grizzlies and Beavers was rained out. It has been rescheduled as part of a double-header at PGE Park on August 12th, slated to begin at 6:05pm.

LAST TIME OUT.....The Grizzlies dropped their second straight game to open the 2008 season, 6-1 to the Portland Beavers at PGE Park on Friday night.....Portland jumped out to a 5-0 lead on the strength of home runs by Edgar Gonzalez and Chip Ambres before the teams traded runs in the 7th inning.....Rehabbing San Francisco Giant Vinnie Chulk started the game, pitching just one scoreless inning, before giving way to scheduled starter Julio Mateo.....Edgar Gonzalez led the Beavers offense with three hits, a home run, and three RBI.....Clay Timpner, Brian Horwitz, and Eliezer Alfonzo all had multi-hit games for Fresno, with Timpner driving in Horwitz for the lone run of the game for the Grizzlies.....

THE BEAVERS.....finished the 2007 season with a record of 58-86, the 15th best mark in the PCL, good for 4th place in the Pacific North division, 16.5 GB.....are managed by Randy Ready, in his first season in Portland.....underwent a color, logo, and uniform change this winter.....ended 2007 by dropping three of four games to Fresno at PGE Park.....hold a 57-41 advantage over the Grizzlies in their all-time series, and a 29-21 edge in games played in Portland.

FIRST TIMER: Emmanuel Burriss' third-inning single off of Shawn Estes on Friday night was the speedster's first professional hit above the Single-A level. Burriss began 2007 with High-A San Jose but after struggling at the plate was sent to Low-A Augusta where he starred offensively, resulting in a jump to Triple-A this year. Burriss, a product of Kent State, burned his way to 68 stolen bases last season, the fourth-highest total in all of professional baseball.

WELCOME BACK: Jesse Foppert's scoreless eighth inning on Friday was his first appearance in a Grizzlies uniform since July 26, 2005. The tall righty, who fast-tracked his way to the big leagues in just his third professional season, is working his way back from injury, and has pitched just 12.1 innings since the end of the 2005 season.

GIANT KILLER: Today's Grizzlies starter, Pat Misch, has already made one start in Fresno's orange-and-black in 2008. Misch started, but did not figure in the decision, in the March 26th exhibition against the San Francisco Giants at Chukchansi Park. Misch hurled 5.0 strong innings, scattering just four hits and allowing an unearned run, in a game won 4-3 by the Grizzlies.

ROAD WOES: Fresno began the 2007 season by winning five or their first six games, all within the friendly confines of Chukchansi Park. In 2006, beginning the summer with eight games on the road like this season, the Grizzlies dropped four straight, and five of their first seven games to open the year.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: *LHP Cesar Ramos (23, 6'2, 190)* was selected by San Diego in the supplemental round (35th overall) of the 2005 Draft out of Long Beach State (CA). Ramos spent the entire 2007 season with Double-A San Antonio (Texas Lg), posting a 13-9 record and 3.41 ERA in 27 starts for the Missions. Ramos' teammates at Long Beach State included current Grizzlies outfielder John Bowker, current Grizzlies catcher Todd Jennings, and current Giants closer Brian Anderson. The southpaw has exhibited an ability to get deep into games, finishing third in the Texas League with 163.2 innings pitched, including a pair of complete-game shutouts, in 2007.
