LAST TIME OUT.....The Grizzlies exploded for 16 hits and 15 runs in a 15-2 series-opening victory over the Tacoma Rainiers on Monday night at Cheney Stadium....Brett Harper, in his first start of the season (DH) was 4-for-6 with a home run, a pair of doubles, and 5 RBI....Scott McClain connected for his first HR of the season in the 3rd inning, and drove in 4 runs in the game....Victor Santos picked up the victory in his Grizzlies debut, striking out four over 5.0 innings....three Fresno relievers combined for 4.0 scoreless frames out of the bullpen....Tacoma's Jeff Clement drove in both Rainier runs with a double in the 4th inning.

THE RAINIERS.....finished the 2007 season with a record of 68-76, the 12th best record in the Pacific Coast League, good for 3rd place in the Pacific North Division....split the 2007 season-series with Fresno (8-8)....are managed by Daren Brown in his second season in Tacoma, and eighth in the Seattle organization overall....feature 2007 PCL MVP Wladimir Balentien....took two-of-three games from Sacramento to open the season....hold a 73-55 advantage in the all-time series with Fresno.

BATTING AROUND: The 15 runs scored by the Grizzlies on Monday night were the most in a game since 7/17/08 when Fresno defeated Tucson 16-1 at Chukchansi Park. The 13-run victory was the largest margin since that date as well.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: Brett Harper became the 34th player in Fresno's 11-year history to collect three extra-base hits with a pair of doubles and a home run on Monday night. The last Grizzly to do so was Scott McClain on 8/21/07 against Salt Lake.

WHEN IT COUNTS: Of the 15 runs scored by Fresno last night, 10 were driven in with two outs in an inning. All four of McClain's RBI, and four of Harper's 5-RBI were collected with two outs in an inning. As a team, the Grizzlies are batting .435 (10-for-23) with two outs and runners in scoring position this season.

SPEED TO BURN: Emmanuel Burriss' 1st inning stolen base on Monday was his first of the 2008 season. Burriss led all Giants farmhands, and ranked 5th in all of professional baseball, with 68 stolen bases in 2007.

THE SOUTH WILL RISE?: Each of the four Pacific South teams (FRE, SAC, TUC, LV) opened the season against squads from the Pacific North division (SL, POR, CS, TAC). Through the first 18 games, the North holds a 13-5 advantage over their rivals from the South.

TRANSACTION: The San Francisco Giants today recalled OF Clay Timpner to the Major League club. Timpner had hit safely in each of Fresno's first four games and driven in six runs for the Grizzlies. To replace Timpner on the roster, the team recalled IF Julio Cordido from Extended Spring Training.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: LHP Ryan Feierabend (22, 6'3, 228) was drafted by Seattle in the 3rd Round of the 2003 Draft out of Midview High School (OH). The southpaw split the 2007 season between Tacoma and Seattle, compiling a 7-10 record and 5.25 ERA in 32 appearances (28 starts) between the two levels. Feierabend earned his first (and only) big-league win on 6/3/07 vs. Texas. He was the winning pitcher in the 2004 Midwest League All-Star Game at the age of 18 and has been young for his level in every season of his professional career. Over his career he has been lauded for having one of the best pick-off moves in the organization.
