**LAST TIME OUT....**The Grizzlies were swept for the first time this season, dropping the finale of their four-game series with Salt Lake by a score of 8-1 at Franklin Covey Field....The Bees scored five runs in the 1st inning against emergency starter Ryan Sadowski in his Triple-A debut....Salt Lake starter Nick Adenhardt earned his 4th win of the season, allowing just three hits over 8.0 innings....Dee Brown homered and drove in three runs for the Bees....Grizzlies reliever Geno Espineli worked 4.2 innings out of the bullpen, allowing just one unearned run....C Eliezer Alfonzo was the only player with a multi-hit game for Fresno and scored the team's only run.

**THE CUBS....**are the Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, an affiliation now in its 28th season....are managed by Pat Listach, who was the team's hitting coach from 2001-2005 and managed the club for 55 games in 2002....finished the 2007 season with a record of 79-65, the 3rd best mark in the PCL and good for 2nd place in the American North Division....swept their four-game series against Fresno last season at Principal Park....currently have the 14th best team batting average and 3rd best team ERA in the Pacific Coast League.

**SWEEP:** The four-game sweep at the hands of the Salt Lake Bees was the first time Fresno has been swept since last July when the Grizzlies were swept in a five-game series by Sacramento at Chukchansi Park. That sweep was part of an eight-game losing streak, the last time the Grizzlies dropped five games in a row.

**UNSUNG HERO:** LHP Geno Espineli's 4.2 inning relief outing on Sunday, in which he allowed just one unearned run, was the longest of his professional career. Espineli, a 14th Round selection in the 2004 Draft, spent the majority of last season and the second-half of 2006 as a starter for Double-A Connecticut.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** According to Baseball America, Iowa's roster features five of Chicago's Top 30 Prospects: RHP Sean Gallagher (5), OF Sam Fuld (18), OF Jake Fox (19), RHP Jose Ascanio (25), and RHP Mark Holliman (27) all rank among the most talented prospects in the Cubs' system.

**TRANSACTION:** LHP Patrick Misch was recalled to San Francisco (NL) on Sunday morning, causing him to miss yesterday's schedule start in Salt Lake. Misch pitched 6.0 innings out of the Giants bullpen on Sunday in relief of Barry Zito against Cincinnati. The southpaw allowed just five hits and two runs (2 solo home runs by B. Phillips) while striking out four in his 2008 Giants debut.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT:** RHP Sean Gallagher (22, 6'2, 225) was selected by Chicago in the 12th Round of the 2004 Draft out of St. Thomas Aquinas H.S. (FL). He enters the 2008 season as the #5 prospect in the Cubs organization according to Baseball America. Gallagher split the 2007 season between three levels in the Cubs system, making his Major League debut on July 9th of last year. The right-hander posted a a 10-3 record and 3.83 era between Double-A Tennessee, Iowa, and Chicago. An All-Star at several levels in his career, Gallagher has reached double-digits in wins in each of his last last three professional seasons. In 2005, after a breakout season with Peoria (LoA-MWL), he was named the Cubs' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and was cited by Baseball America as having the best breaking ball in the Midwest League. He is the reigning Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week.
